The Rules

1. Participants should not possess or use mobile phones during the course of the Smagam. In case of any emergencies, campers are requested to get in touch with the sevadaars at the smagam. Campers violating this rule will have their phones being confiscated and they will only be returned on the last day of the Smagam.
2. Participants may not use, possess, distribute or sell any alcoholic drinks, tobacco products and/or drugs while in attendance at the Smagam.
3. Participants found tampering with any in-house equipment at Makindu Sikh Temple will be dismissed from the Smagam and the cost of repairing or replacing the damaged equipment will be forwarded to them.
4. Participants may not interfere with any security system or tamper with any locks at Makindu Sikh Temple.
5. Lewd and offensive speech and actions that undermine the Smagam are strictly prohibited and those encouraging these may stand to being evicted from the Smagam.
6. Under no circumstances are male campers to visit female camper rooms and vice-versa.
7. Vandalism and pranks will not be tolerated.
8. Day visitors are not allowed in the sleeping area. Family and Visitors must inform and check with the sevadaars if wanting to visit the campers during the Smagam.
9. Participants found out of their rooms after lights out will be immediately dismissed from the Smagam with no refund.
10. Non-attendance of any timetabled event (apart from sickness) will not be tolerated and participants found guilty of doing so may stand to face strict disciplinary actions.
